

**Handover of New Territories South Animal Management Centre and
Shatin Plant Quarantine Station**

The MTR Corporation today (29 November 2013) handed over the reprovisioned New Territories South Animal Management Centre and Shatin Plant Quarantine Station to the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD).

The new three-storey Animal Management Centre and single-storey Plant Quarantine Station, with a gross floor area of approximately 2,300 sq. m, were completed two months ahead of schedule.

As part of the Shatin to Central Link Project, the existing Animal Management Centre and Plant Quarantine Station in Che Kung Miu Road will be removed to facilitate the construction of the new Hin Keng Station of the Shatin to Central Link, which is targeted for completion in 2018.
