

**Temporary Relocation of Public Transport Interchange at Wan Chai North
For Construction of Exhibition Station under Shatin to Central Link Project**

Starting from 17 May 2015 (Sunday) around 1am, the Public Transport Interchange (PTI) adjacent to Fleming Road at Wan Chai North will be temporarily relocated to a newly reclaimed area near Marsh Road. The move is being made to facilitate the construction of Exhibition Station under the Shatin to Central Link Project (SCL). The PTI will be reinstated at its original location upon completion of the railway project.

To facilitate smooth transport connections after the relocation, new temporary bus stops will be provided along Convention Avenue, Hung Hing Road, Fleming Road, Harbour Road and Expo Drive East to allow convenient drop off and pick up points for passengers. Large banners and signage have been posted up and leaflets are being distributed in the vicinity to inform the public of the new traffic arrangements.


Caring Ambassadors have been deployed since 5 May to assist passengers until end of May. There will be no change to the number of traffic lanes and directions on nearby roads during the construction period. The 17-kilometre SCL is a territory-wide strategic railway project which will connect Exhibition Station and Admiralty Station on Hong Kong Island with the existing East Rail Line at Hung Hom Station via the fourth cross-harbour rail tunnel, greatly enhancing the convenience of travel and connectivity between urban areas and the New Territories.
